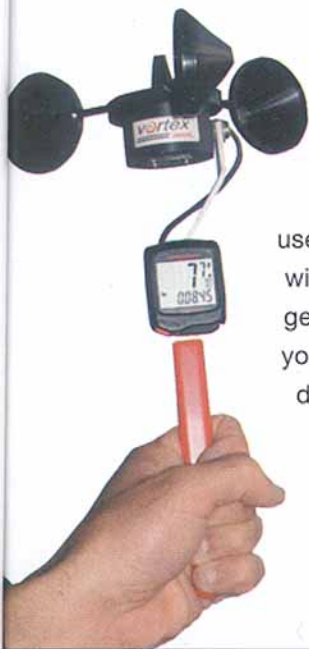


WIND METER WITH A TWIST
